I moved into Hill House with my family in 1953 and I have a good and full knowledge of how the shed has been used since then, as well as how it is currently used today.

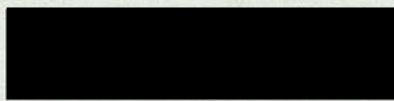
