I object. The Council has committed to climate emergency actions, including reducing emissions within a few short years. How does the Council offset these ambitions if granting an application of this nature. An application, which is clearly not based on local/community needs given the amount of vacant warehouses and industrial space in and around town and the two warehouses sitting idle on the A361 near the M40 in Banbury.

Traffic is a constant throughout the day on all roads leading to the M40 junction with key points during the day horrendous to navigate.
