The land is bordered by an old Cotswold stone wall, at a road junction within the village. There is one existing telegraph pole, and the remains a a beautiful tree which was lost in a storm. It would be far more appropriate to plant a replacement tree than have this mast installed.</p> <p>There are houses close to the site. The proposed mast would be visually intrusive and out of place in the setting which is a conservation area.</p> <p>A site visit would be beneficial to assess the situation.</p> <p>There would be a number of well informed and knowledgable villagers who would be pleased to show a visitor around the area.</p>
