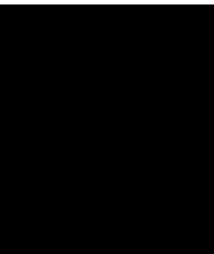
Thank you for publishing details of the outline application for 170 dwellings near Hanwell.
