<b>Comments</b>	<p>Dear Sir/Madam,</p> <p>I am writing to express my objection to the proposed plan to build 170 new houses near the village of Hanwell. I believe that this development would have a negative impact on the local community and environment.</p> <p>Firstly, the construction of such a large number of houses would put a strain on local infrastructure, including roads, public transport and healthcare facilities. Hanwell is a small village with limited resources, and the addition of so many new residents would inevitably lead to overcrowding and increased demand for services.</p> <p>Secondly, the proposed development would have a significant impact on the natural environment. The two fields in question have been farmed on for years, growing wheat, rape and peas.</p> <p>Furthermore, the construction process itself is likely to cause significant disruption to the local community, including noise pollution, traffic congestion, and dust and debris.
