I strongly object to this development on several grounds.

Firstly, this development is completely out of scope given Cherwell's five year planning cycle, of which they are ahead, ensuring that there is no need for this at all.

Secondly, for those of us who live in the surrounding villages around Banbury, this is another creep of identikit housing which will decimate much valued and needed green spaces. We have already seen ancient hedgerows ripped out on the opposite side of the road to this development where there will shortly be another 300 houses. The people in Hanwell in particular and surrounding villages chose to live in a rural village - not a suburb of Banbury. This will have a huge impact on their quality of life in terms of light and noise pollution, as well as additional traffic.

As a London commuter - I can testify that Chiltern Railways is already unable to cope with the volume of passengers it has, with the access roads, car parks and trains struggling to manage - and this is post Covid commuter numbers. This also goes for local doctors, schools and other facilities - where will the increase in these be when you add in potentially another 500 plus people and their associated vehicles?

This development is simply not required and I strongly object to it.
