Comments	<p>This development goes against the planning policy of the council. It will destroy an historic village when there are plenty of other sites that could be built on (brown field).</p> <p>The fact that Hanwell is a village attracts many locals to visit for events such as Hanfest as well as for the pub, park and general interest in the buildings. Much of this would not happen if Hanwell is no longer a village. Events such as Hanfest bring money to the village (which go straight back into upkeep of things such as the village hall, ensuring that the village is not a drain on public resources), some of these funds also go to local charities.</p> <p>In addition, the increased level of traffic and local infrastructure cannot sustain a further 170 houses in this location - the local schools are already at capacity (Hanwell fields has already taken an extra 100 children this year and does have the necessary teaching staff to support a further increase).</p>
