Comments	<p>Dear sirs,</p> <p>I have reviewed many of the submissions already made and in particular the one made by Mrs Jane Huskisson resonates deeply. I have lived in the village of Horley for some 63 years and observed with mountain consternation the constant expansion of Banbury in all directions in a largely piecemeal fashion. In addition to her well-made points there are the following considerations:</p> <p>There is no NHS dentistry available to new patients in Banbury, and this situation continues to deteriorate.</p> <p>There is no capacity availability for new patients in primary healthcare, and again this situation continues to deteriorate.</p> <p>There is no veterinary capacity available.</p> <p>The resources of the Horton hospital I continually being downgraded with the consequent necessity to travel for any major treatment.</p> <p>There is no public transport route serving the area, and again services are being reduced overall rather than increased.</p> <p>None of the developments at Hardwick and Hanwell fields contained dedicated bike lanes and there was seemingly no provision for these to be introduced in the future.</p> <p>Thames Water already has a severe problem with respect to sewage pollution and CSO outfall and yet further development would aggravate the situation.</p> <p>Indications given by Cherwell district council suggest that villages will be given more protection under the new plan, details of which have not as yet been released. It would seem that this application is an opportunistic attempt to obtain permission prior to the introduction of the new plan.</p> <p>Yours faithfully, Charles Cozens.</p>
