I would like to object to this application as this proposed development would join the village of Hanwell onto Banbury, thus destroying the character and integrity of this beautiful village. This development would compromise the green buffer that has been in place as a boundary to the edge of the town.

The proposed development would also harm the character and heritage assets of Hanwell.

The 12 th century Church would have a clear view of the proposed houses.
