## SCHEDULE OF DETAILS

#### Condition 38:

Partial discharge of Condition 38 to 18/00825/HYBRID – Flying Field Strategies – in respect only to the Lighting Strategy, Signage Strategy, Waste Management Strategy, Air Conditioning Strategy, Alarms Strategy and the Parking Strategy [except where it does not apply to the listed buildings (Building Nos. 325, 327, 328 & 340) nor any structure within the Scheduled Monuments (the Quick Response Area, Northern Bomb Stores & Building 299) nor to the Car Processing Compound Storage Area] and excluding the Fencing Strategy.

In accordance with the document entitled 'Heyford Park Flying Field Strategies' by Pegasus Group, Ref: P22-1611, dated 7<sup>th</sup> March 2023 but only in respect to Appendices 2 - 5 and 7 - 8.

#### INFORMATIVE

A Fencing Strategy and a Parking Strategy in respect to all of the Listed Buildings, all structures within the Scheduled Monument areas and the Car Processing Compound Storage Area are still required before Condition 38 to 18/00825/HYBRID can be fully discharged.
