During the estimated 30 events these vehicles will all arrive, and leave, in a very short window on the day. Traffic build up will be huge, as will pollution. Varying events will involve the use of the perimeter track as well as the three tracks that are going to appear on the airfield. Not only are we likely to be able to hear the noise generated by event music, tannoys, etc. But also the endless car accelerating and tyre screeching we are already having to endure. It is a fact that a large number of car drivers arriving for the Scramble, for instance, take great pleasure in revving their engines in order to produce as much noise as possible from their out of limits exhausts. Including loud back firing. So, on one side of Caversfield we have an Eco village and on the other side a venue that is going to produce nothing but noise, excess traffic and pollution. Does this make sense? I strongly object to a historic grass omni directional airfield being turned into nothing but a petrol head destination and a huge events area. This is totally the wrong location with no consideration for all the residents of Caversfield, Glory Farm and even Launton, who's peace will be disturbed potentially 30 weekends out of 52. We used to live next to an airfield. Now we live next to a place that is aiming to be one of the top 10 attractions in the UK. What about those of us who live here?"/>
