Primarily, through removal of BS5837 category C trees to the sites frontage adjacent to the Oxford road. I am aware these trees require removal in order to accommodate the site access, as well as the widening of the carriageway. On site, discussion was held regarding reten • on of select trees along this sec • on, which concluded this was not feasible. Higher quality trees within the rest of the site are highlighted to be retained, with su • cient bu • ers surrounding category A trees.

Key to this proposal is a detailed landscape/tree plan•ng strategy for the site, as mi•ga•on for removals. At this stage, I am not convinced the current level of detail within the landscaping strategy ful•ls this requirement. I am happy to consider this alongside the views of CDC landscape Architect. I appreciate such ma•ers are commonly addressed at the reserved ma•ers stage however, I am keen to ensure su• cient space is a•orded at the outline stage to ensure a robust tree/landscape strategy is implemented as a principle component to the site.
