4.1 Bioregional Sustainability Consultants: Have no objection to the condition being discharged.

### 5. APPRAISAL

5.1 The applicants have submitted a full PV schedule which is available and is provided, which includes MCS calculations of output. It should be noted that the MCS calculated demonstrates a total CO2 saving of 99,315kgCO2/year, significantly higher than the SAP calculated figure of circa 95,000kgCO2/year, therefore the submitted information is considered to be acceptable and condition 24 can be discharged.
