T121 Beech - selective branch removal and pruning to remove small branches, twigs and foliage from directly beneath and in front (roadside) of the lighting column and head and ensure no branches are in contact with the lighting column with a 1m clearance - subject to TPO 33/2022

Appraisal

Site visit. The placement of a lighting column beneath a category A tree reflects poor forward planning. The proposal however reflects the minimum required to mitigate the immediate conflict between the tree and lighting column.

- 3. All tree works shall be carried out in accordance with British Standard 3998: Recommendations for Tree Works and undertaken by suitably qualified and insured arboricultural contractors.
 - Reason In the interests of health and safety and good arboricultural practice and Government guidance contained within the National Planning Policy Framework.
- 4. The works shall not involve any reduction in height or spread of the tree, the removal of any branch of which any part is more than 50mm or any pollarding.
 - Reason In the interests of health and safety and good arboricultural practice and Government guidance contained within the National Planning Policy Framework.
