Thank you for consulting the conservation team on the Request for an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Scoping Opinion for the development proposals at Stratfield Brake Motorcycle Track, Oxford Road, Kidlington.

It is agreed that the designated heritage assets identified in terms of built heritage should be scoped into the Environmental Statement. It is also agreed that these assets lie within the wider area surrounding the site and there are no Heritage Assets within the site itself.

With regard to non-designated heritage assets, it is also agreed that there are no non-designated heritage assets identified within the site. The approach to identifying non-designated heritage assets through the consultation process is agreed with.

The assessment of archaeology and landscape is deferred to the relevant consultees.

Overall, the methodology and approach to assessment is agreed with.
