Comments	I would like to object to the above planning application on the grounds that, as per all the previous applications, the access to the new housing is not safe. The A4095 is a busy A road which is always impacted by any problems on the A34 or M40, and these instances are becoming more frequent. As well as this, the proposed access is on a bend in the road just where the speed limit changes from 50 to 20 miles an hour as you enter the village. My own drive is only slightly further along the road and, in my experience, cars have rarely slowed down to 20 mph by the time they reach my drive and cars exiting the village speed up as soon as they pass the Bletchingdon Road. I really believe that the proposed access will increase the number of accidents on this part of the road because of the combination of poor visibility and speeding cars. Applications to build on this land have been rejected over and over again and as this is reall the same application again with a different number of houses, it should be rejected as the previous ones have been.
