Remove epicormic growth from main stem upto crown break, remove deadwood, reduce the lower/mid elongated branching by a maximum of 3metres, reduce the height by a maximum of 2.5 metres. T2 - Remove epicormic growth from main stem upto crown break, remove deadwood, reduce the lower/mid elongated branching by a maximum of 2.5metres, reduce the height by a maximum of 2 metres. T3 - Remove epicormic growth from main stem upto crown break, remove deadwood, remove 2-3 lower small diameter branches extended directly over the property roof line to provide a 2m clearance, reduce the lower/mid crown branching by a maximum of 2 metres by way of selective end weight reduction/thinning, reduce the height by a maximum of 2.5 metres. (resulting works to enhance the 3 trees group cohesion and symmetry)"/>
