Once again another unsuitable application has come forward for this site. I find it quite astounding that more warehousing is being proposed bearing in mind that across the road lies empty units. The traffic on this side of Banbury is horrendous, you now have HS2 lorries back and forwards through Banbury, along with the 11 O'clock Amazon van rush and if any accidents happen on the M40 happen everything grinds to a halt. We actually moved away from Middleton Cheney because the tailbacks were becoming intolerable.. This site would occupy unspoilt greenfield site which provides a buffer between Banbury, Middleton Cheney and Chacombe. There are many sites for redevelopment within Banbury but it somehow seems acceptable to keep taking greenfield sites. One would assume in the new year that some new development of the General Foods site will be proposed. The approach to Banbury via the motorway is now like Shed City and just looks awful, when will there be proper investment in the town centre, including historic buildings that have been neglected for years.
