Comments	<input type="text" value="There is already a high level of heavy goods traffic that travel through the A422 cutting distance out of the M40 route to the A43, travelling through small rural roads. Increases number of factories or distribution centres will increase this load. The road through Farthinghoe on the A422 is tiny, it is very dangerous coming past a truck coming the other way. Also there is pedestrian traffic on the sidewalk in Farthinghoe, it is dangerous to them.

We should not be tearing up greenfield or agricultural land for more massive warehouses. There is plenty of land that cannot be used for agricultural purpose or wildlife that can be used for factories, even if it is slightly off the motorway, and add 5mins to a trucks logistics time!

My objection is this simple: we should not be building large warehouse capacity over green land and wildlife, so that Amazon or other can shave another 10mins off their delivery time. Prioritise nature, open land, wildlife and the world originally intended OVER industrial growth, financial short term gain and profits."/>
