Comments	The land proposed to be developed is 'historic' agricultural land with clearly defined Ridge and Furrow. This will be destroying an important wildlife habitat which has been mostly undisturbed for 100's of years. The development of land around the M40 junction has already increased the flood risk to Banbury and this further development will not ease that situation. In terms of traffic while adjacent to the M40, Junction 11 is already a very busy junction with the large number of industrial areas already in the town. Queues to this roundabout are common. The link roads west to the M1 via the A422 and A361 are already overloaded and cannot take additional haulage vehicles. This will be increasing local pollution levels. The A roads in Northampton are already in poor condition and this development will have a bigger impact on Northants roads than Cherwell ones. There are already a number of empty warehouses in Banbury - we do not need more. This land is a natural Green belt buffer towards Middleton. Middleton Cheney has already taken more development than is can cope with and this will only encourage further infill between Banbury and Middleton & Warkworth which will ruin the rural nature of these villages. This is purley a profit motivated development rather than a need driven one.
