Comments	<p>We object on the following grounds:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The location of the proposed site is inappropriate for families to live and work from. It is very close to the concrete manufacturing site which cannot be good for health of occupants, especially children and the elderly.2. The site originally was a wetland meadow with ponds and wildlife. Already there has been total disregard to the welfare of the site and the ecology thereon.3. There are no amenities in the closest village of Piddington.4. There is no footpath for occupants from the site, hence making the area dangerous for both pedestrians and drivers alike.5. There is a very high water table on the site and a danger of sewage getting into the water course from leakage of septic tanks.6. It is likely there will be lorries and large vehicles coming in and out of the site onto an unclassified country lane which is narrow and sited on a blind bend, this will make it a dangerous site for both the occupants and villagers alike.7. There surely must be more appropriate sites within the Cherwell District which will be suitable as opposed to a remote location in a very rural and beautiful area.8. Graven Hill has much more available space, there is already ample hardstanding, there are transport links to the local shops and schools, safer access and is already on the sewage network, unlike the proposed site at Piddington.
