<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="I object to this application on the following grounds:&lt;br/&gt;- The existing planning consent has been invalidated by starting work BEFORE fulfilling the pre-commencement conditions. Therefore, it should not be possible to extend an invalidated application.&lt;br/&gt;- Approving the extension would set a dangerous precedent which could undermine the enforceability of future pre-commencement conditions set by Cherwell District Council.&lt;br/&gt;- The unlawful works have already caused extensive damage to the site, which has a fragile ecology (even more so now) and is an important location for the endangered Great Crested Newts. Any extension will inevitably cause yet more damage.&lt;br/&gt;Cherwell District Council has a duty to enforce its own rules and ensure that breaching any of its rules will not be tolerated.
