Comments	<input type="text" value="I object vehemently to the latest application made by this landowner to provide 12 plots on this field. The repercussions on biodiversity, flooding and visual impact (and safety) would be huge. If CDC can only show a shortfall of 3 sites, why the justification for an additional 6?

The additional road traffic from this location would be significant; the number of daily journeys along this minor road and through the tight roads of Piddington would be of major concern.

The landowner has already destroyed ponds and other animal habitats as well extending beyond the area permitted.

I totally disagree that this is a sustainable development. This would be a large development on a minor road with no services. Flooding is also a concern and the amount of infrastructure to enable a site of this size is obviously unsustainable.

I urge CDC to refuse this application.
