Comments	<input type="text" value="I wish to object to this retrospective planning application,. The site is on a green field , it has already been spoilt by filling in ponds and making concrete standings ,work which has been carried out regardless of the conditions imposed at the previous application. Piddington is a small, quiet village which has narrow roads and no amenities. The sight has no services and the road is unsuitable for large vehicles turning in or out on a narrow bend,. The site is near a concrete batching plant which is noisy and dusty.It adjoins the MOD site and is close to pylons. It is the home of a wide variety of wildlife especially The Great Crested Newt. Land in this area quickly becomes waterlogged and floods. there is a danger that run off could contaminate the streams and ditches feeding into the River Ray. I urge the council to consider other brown field sites rather than this green field site which is totally unsuitable and reject this application."/>
