Foster Site Address: Land south of Widnell Lane, Bicester</p> <p>I wish to make an objection to the above application.</p> <p>I'm struggling to comprehend why this application is labelled as 'Retrospective' planning when there's nothing retrospective about it. It appears perplexing that the planning department didn't reject it initially. The term 'Retrospective' implies that the application pertains to something that has already taken place. However, this is not the case here. It's worth noting that prior attempts to gain permission for additional pitches on this development were unsuccessful, having been denied by the Cherwell District Council and dismissed upon appeal multiple times. Furthermore, the original planning application for the 6 pitches is in violation of its pre-planning conditions, which, in my understanding, should render it invalid. Moreover, with the expansion of the neighbouring cement processing plant, this site seems even less suitable for habitation than before.
