<b>Comments</b>	<p>I am a resident in Caversfield, Bicester who objects the idea of building 99 houses onland west of Fringford Road in Caversfield.</p> <p>I truly understand the need to add more houses for families to live and in turn provide more economy for Bicester. But Bicester is not just famous for its wide selection of shops providing vast brilliant best quality goods for people from all over the world but also for its great green scenery. People enjoy to explore and see the wild trees &amp; flowers, especially when they take their dogs with them.
