Results of the survey from Kidlington Parish council show a huge majority of local residents object to these proposals.
Oxford United have not sufficiently explored staying at the Kassam or going elsewhere. This stadium would be a local traffic disaster. The idea of closing the main road to Oxford for several hours on match days is ludicrous and extremely damaging to local residents. How will we get our children to clubs and churches in Oxford - must we stay at home on match days?
Inevitably football fans will park in south Kidlington on match days in significant numbers, as happens everywhere else - even where proposals are put forward for public transport. That's just human nature. No serious study has been made into the likely traffic problems, just wishful thinking. South Kidlington will become a car park or a restricted permit zone, which we do not want!
There has been no proposal for safe access to the site.
This is green belt land and should be treated as such! This is an environmental nightmare."/>
