This application is based on a false proposition that Oxford United have to leave their current ground, something the owner has refuted in current months. This proposal will destroy a thriving eclogically sound business as well as closing the Kidlington Gap for good. It will cause an increase in rail and road users both of which are over-stretched beyond capacity at present. Oxford Parkway is a small station ill-suited to handling the numbers who will attend on match days. Trains are already over-crowded and it can be hard to get a seat which means they are essentially inaccessible for elderly users such as myself.
