Dear Sir

I am writing to complain about the building of a stadium for Oxford United Football Club in the Green Belt.. This stadium is just not suitable for this area because of the following reasons

1. There is no provisions for parking on site and this will impart on the local environment.
2. The amount of traffic converging on the area on Match days would cause traffic congestion and it would impact greatly on Kidlington people who wish to use the road to go into Oxford or other places.
