<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="I would like to register my support for the above application number submitted by Oxford United FC.&lt;br/&gt;As a resident of the county of 60 years and a club supporter for 55 of those, the proposed new site near Kidlington is the most sensible that I have seen in all of the time that the club has been searching for a suitable site.&lt;br/&gt;The current stadium at Grenoble Road is difficult to access and leave, the facilities are meagre and can in no way be described as sustainable. The Triangle site near Kidlington is situated close to both rail and bus terminals and will certainly negate the need for me and my family to use our car other than to travel from our village to a nearby station or park and ride facility. The stadium plans have clearly been well thought out and will be as eco-friendly as any in the country, if not more so.&lt;br/&gt;It seems to me that a stadium situated on the Triangle will have little impact on residents of Kidlington on the relatively few match days, while decreasing traffic as those travelling will be using mainly public transport due to the restricted nature of parking facilities at the new stadium.&lt;br/&gt;I would strongly encourage you to approve the plans and very much look forward to you doing so."/>
