We feel it will provide a great source of facilities which are lacking in the village of Kidlington and will provide an attraction for our young people to engage with. Having a professional sports club on our doorstep will be inspirational for the local young sports players. Stratfield Brake will be improved and maintained as part of the deal by Oxford Utd and that will save the local parish council approx 130,000 per year, which they will hopefully put back into local sports facility improvements. Many of the current sporting facilities in Kidlington are not fit for purpose and a massive investment is required. The section 106 money which will come from the stadium construction could be used to bring several sports grounds in and around the village up to date. This will offer the opportunity for young and old to improve fitness and mental well-being in facilities that the village can be proud of.
