Comments	<input type="text" value="It is clear that the proposed development of the stadium will cause huge disruption at a sensitive point of the main entry road to the city from the north. Ambulances to and from the JR and police and fire vehicles from Kidlington will all be affected. So will those using buses and the park and ride for a whole range of reasons which instead will be dominated by matchgoers to the exclusion of the general public including those catching trains at Oxford Parkway. The club have been disingenuous in claiming to be forced to move when they have deliberately made themselves homeless, presumably as a tactic to blackmail local politicians who will not wish to forego the votes of the club's supporters. It is a complete scandal. The claims of environmental improvement by building on ancient woodland and adding a few pot plants are laughable. It is also totally unclear how this will benefit anyone other than presumably the finances of the club and its investors. Claims of service to the local community are so vague as to be obviously bogus. I can't understand how any reasonable person could have allowed this charade to go so far without seeing though it."/>
