Comments	<input type="text" value="I object to the proposed Football Stadium at Stratfield Brake for the following reasons.
1) Taken with all the other planning proposals, Housing on the Golf Course, Housing at Water Eaton, opposite the planned stadium, Housing at Stratfield Brake next to the playing fields opposite the planned stadium, a huge amount of natural habitat and wildlife will be lost and there will be no green space between Kidlington and Oxford.
2) The traffic will cause major delays to local people travelling by bus between Kidlington, Oxford Parkway and Oxford City on Event Days.
3) Oxford Parkway, Jordan Hill, Cutteslow park will not be assessable for large parts of match days by Public Transport.
4) Closing the road for any event will send traffic leaving the Park and Ride towards Oxford, totally defeating the object of the Park and Ride in keeping traffic away from the Ring Road
5) The residents, local to the Stadium, will be greatly affected by on street parking and access to their properties as well as away supporters travelling between local pubs and the stadium, as happens at other Football Stadiums, along with noise, especially at night matches and Music Events"/>
