Comments	<input type="text" value="I am writing to put my objection to the planning application of Oxford United's new stadium. I can not find a single positive point that would benefit Kidlington and it's residence. Here are my key objections.
Volume of traffic on match days, the roads can already be busy particularly at weekends. There is almost no provision for parking apart from suggesting supporters using the Park and Ride and Oxford Parkway car parks which where not built for that reason and will cause genuine users problems in parking when they want to go into Oxford City. (the whole point of the car park is to prevent traffic in the city)
There will definitely be risks to the supporters when they are trying to cross the road to the stadium. When I mentioned this to a representative of the proposal his answer was closing the road for an hour before the match and two hours after matches which quite frantically was ludicrous.
