Comments	<input type="text" value="I live very near the planned site - and have done so for over twenty years. Over the years the changes locally have resulted in extremely heavy traffic and congestion, at all the junctions from Summertown to Kidlington. The other major problem is drainage: a very minor rainfall leads to flooded roads and drains overflowing. This development will make both these problems far worse. The traffic is likely to be at a standstill on match days. Oxford Parkway station will be used as a car park even for those not travelling by train and huge numbers of cars will be attracted into Oxford at a time when residents are being asked to reduce car use and are restricted in car use. I am horrified at the loss of green space, opportunities for wildlife and ecological health. We are supposed to be striving for a greener environment so why concrete over a green area, not for the benefit of residents or the environment, but for commercial gain for shareholders? This development offers no advantages to residents, only damage to our already fragile environment. The Kassam stadium already exists, is well-served by major roads, there is no reason why it should not continue to be used for OUFC."/>
