Dear Sir/madam. I write to register my objection to the OUFC application to erect a football stadium on the triangle. I find many reasons to be worried. Secondly the site is well known and documented for its exceptional biodiversity which would be permanently lost if built on. Thirdly, there would be the impact on the landscape and exceptional tree loss, again, irreversible. Fourthly there would be a very serious impact on the area from congestion and parking problems in the residential area nearby. Lastly the area would suffer more flooding caused by loss of drainage.
