	<ul> <li>Government policy and guidance: THIS IS A GREEN SPACE - Green Belt</li> <li>The NPPF (National Planning Policy Framework) states that inappropriate development on the Green Belt is not allowed unless there are 'very special circumstances' (VSC)</li> <li>OUFC acknowledges that the stadium is inappropriate development and that it would cause harm to the Green Belt.</li> <li>Traffic will hugely increase in the area which will have a detrimental impact on kidlington residents such as myself.</li> <li>According to OUFC 83.1% of supporters currently travel by private car/van.
