Comments	We object strongly to the application on the following grounds:
	> Traffic congestion: Daily traffic in this area is already very heavy and often subjected to long delays. An extra 16,000 match-goers/leavers will exacerbate the problem. It is estimated that 83% of OUFC supporters travel by car. That is potentially over 13,000 extra cars (or 6,500 if shared journeys) in the area on match days.
	>Parking: Extra parking will be required for these cars in an area where parking is already a premium. All of this when the Northern Gateway development (with 480 new homes planned) is well under way and will greatly increase the pressure for parking.
	> Highway Safety: Additional traffic and a lack of parking space can only create safety concerns.
