I am a resident of Kidlington and also an Oxford United season ticket holder for home matches but am strongly against the building of a football stadium on the Triangle in Kidlington. Having read a letter from Kevin Cox, Designing Out Crime Officer, Thames Valley Police Headquarters South dated 27 September 2023 entitled 'EIA Scoping Opinion' I wonder if OUFC have considered all the safety points mentioned? There is considerable concern in Kidlington about parking in the village, especially in the vicinity of the Triangle. At the Kassam Stadium I have seen what happens at the end of matches with people rushing from the stadium, and I imagine that the footfall at the Triangle would be similar but with people coming out onto the roads immediately by the stadium causing problems with the traffic. In the Oxford United match programmes recently has appeared an advertisement for PLANETOX a music festival by Oxford United to be held next month at The Bullingdon: I feel sure that if/when the stadium is built they will not pay to hire a venue, they will use the stadium, hence a lot of extra noise and pollution. It seems unbelievable that OUFC does not have a Plan B and are obviously not considering staying at the Kassam Stadium despite Firoz Kassam saying they can stay. Why are Oxford United Football Club being so secretive? Please do not let us lose more Green Belt or close the Kidlington Gap or destroy the biodiverse wildlife habitat. Please consider families of people laid to rest in the nearby recently opened Kidlington Cemetery on Bicester Road. Please also consider the residents of Kidlington, Yarnton, Begbroke and Water Eaton who will be the ones to suffer if this monstrosity is built on one of the entrance points to Kidlington"/>
