I object to the above proposal

I am a resident of Linkside Avenue and have already the unpleasant experience:

- of the traffic conditions in the area - getting worse with each passing year
- of considerable pollution from the nearby A34
- of travelling from Parkway to London by Chiltern Railways - often overcrowded

In addition:

Concreting over such a large area, as well as all the building already started or about to start nearby will make flooding more likely in the future. Whether we like it or not, climate is changing, and longer rainy spells are a strong possibility.

The neighbouring roads are already very busy with accompanying noise and pollution. On match days parking will spread well beyond the stadium facilities and likely impact the Linkside/Lakeside Avenue area.

I strongly object to this new stadium being built on the triangle site as it will impact negatively on our quality of life. I hope that OUFC will reconsider renegotiating the lease of their present venue.
