I wish to object to the proposed development of the land to the west of Oxford Parkway station, whereby it is proposed to build a Football Stadium and Hotel. My objection concerns:

- the fact that it seems that Oxford United does not have to leave the Kassam stadium, despite statements to the contrary
- the fact that this proposed development seems to be as much about increasing the revenue of the club, with the inclusion of a hotel - at least the shopping mall seems to be off the cards now...
