Comments	<input type="text" value="Despite the Council ecologist's recommendation there are no proposals for integrated nest bricks for birds.
I propose that all the sites where bird boxes are proposed should have integrated bird's nest bricks. If bricks designed for Swifts are chosen these would be suitable for other species as well (House Sparrows and Starlings included).
Other reasons why Swift bricks should be used are detailed in the document attached. If these are used there is space for at least 12.
