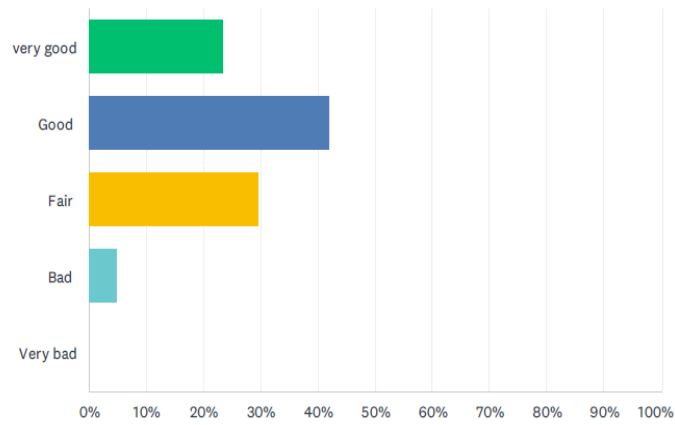

Q1 In general, over the last year would say your health has been?

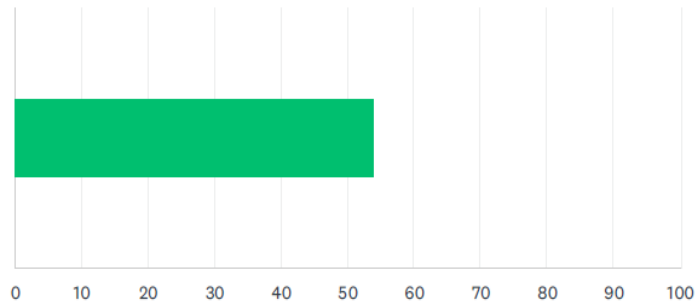

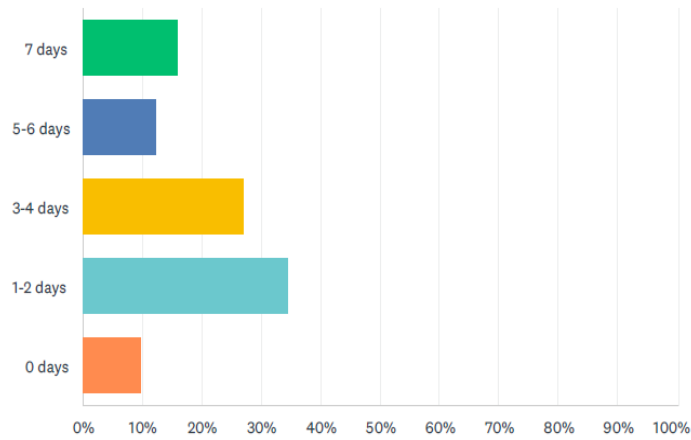

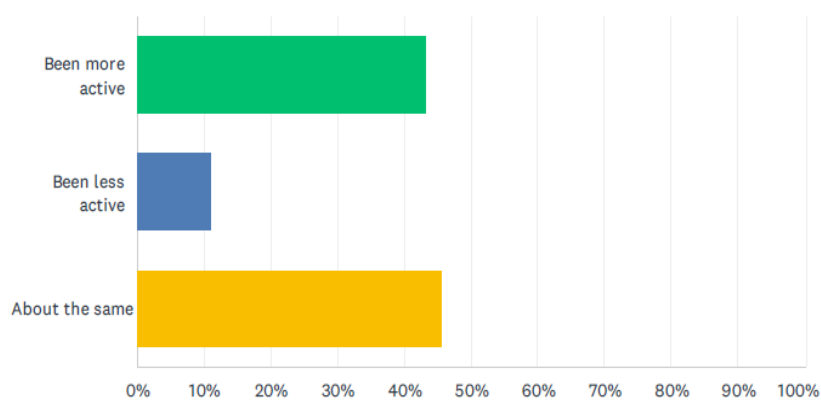

Q4 In terms of physical activity. Comparing time during lockdown to current physical activity levels, have you:

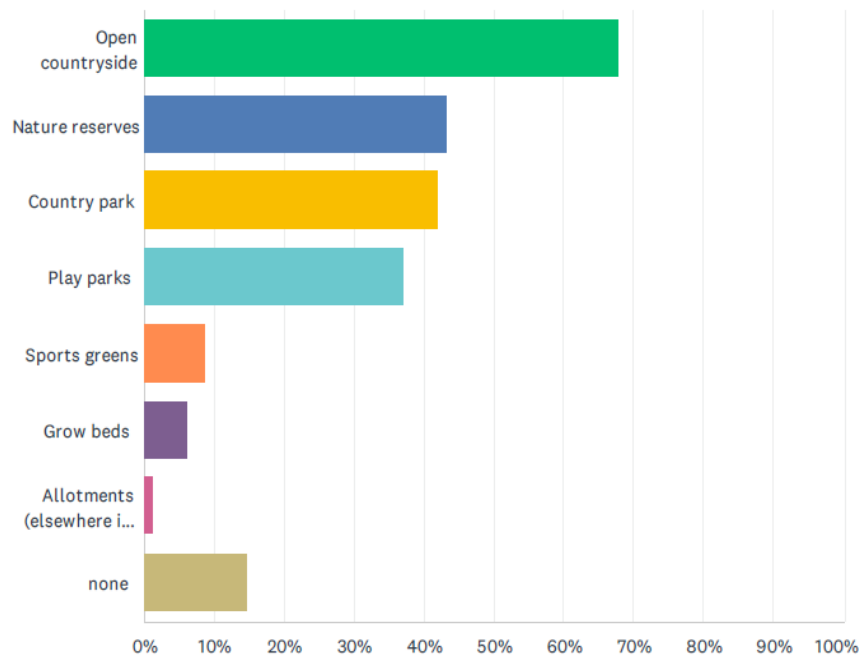

Q5 Which of the following green spaces does your household make use of locally? (please select all that apply)

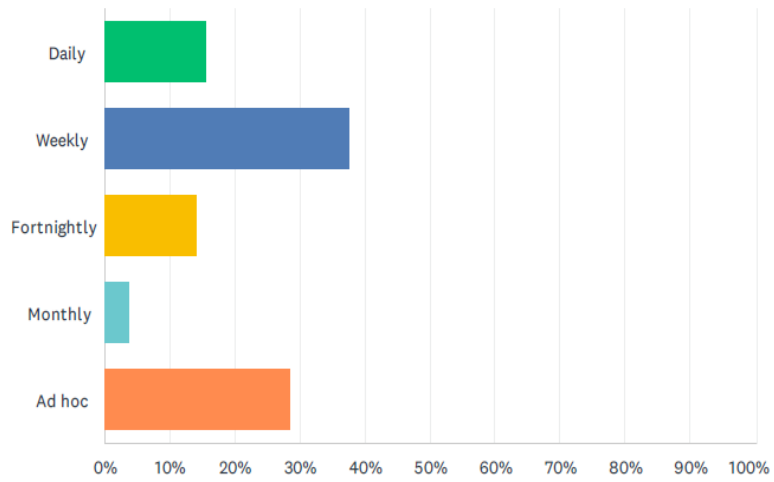

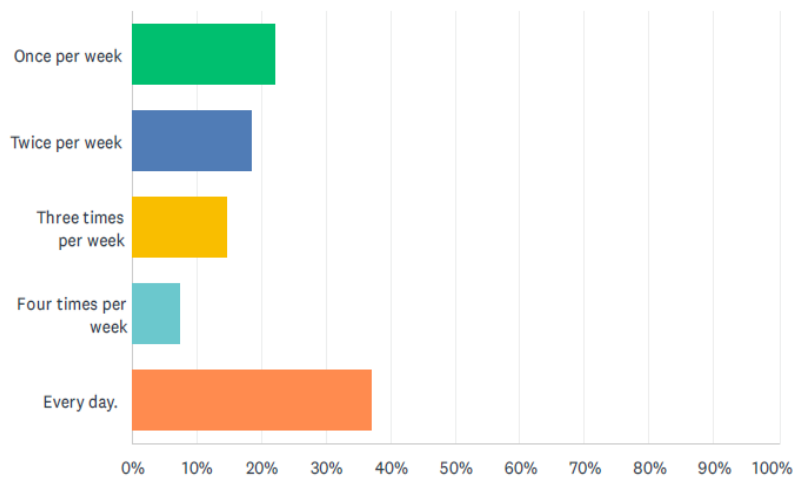

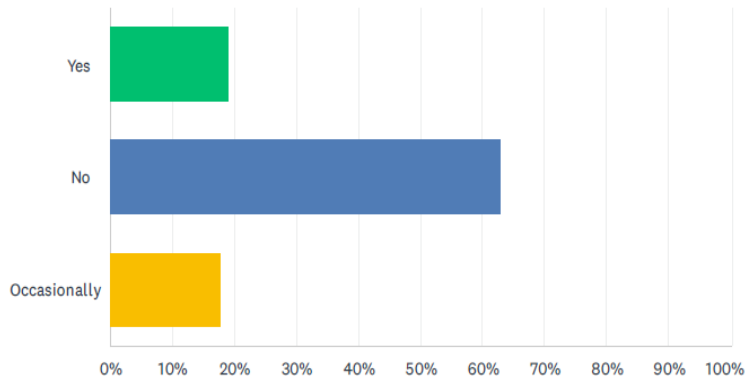

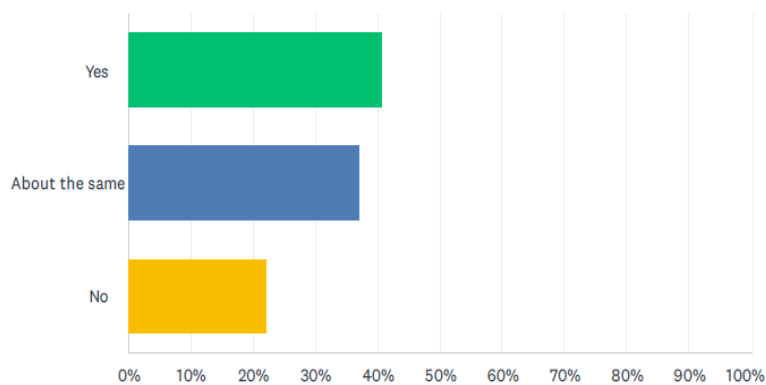

Q9 As result of the COVID-19 Pandemic are you using delivery companies more for your shopping and food? E.g. Amazon, Ocado etc

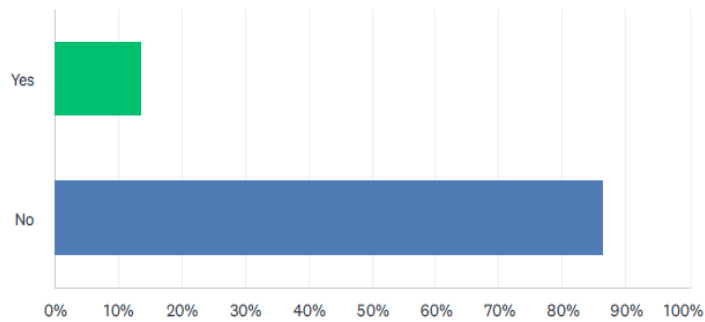

Q10 Do you currently use a local farm fruit or vegetable box delivery service?

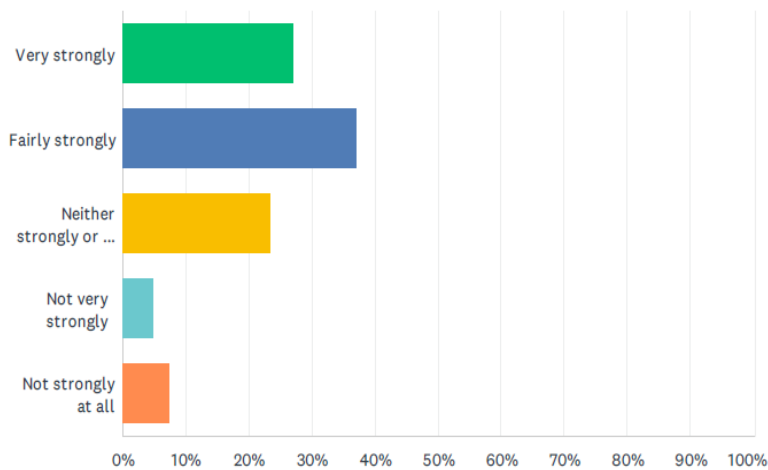

Q11 Since moving to Elmsbrook how strongly do you feel you belong to your immediate neighborhood?

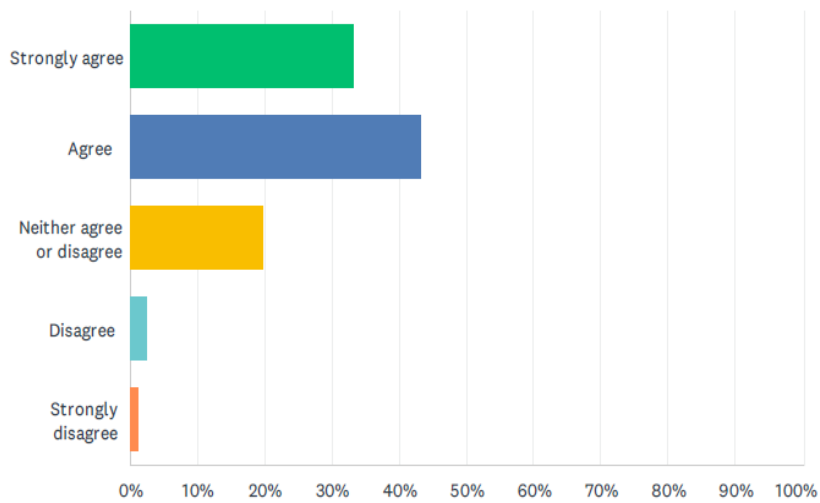

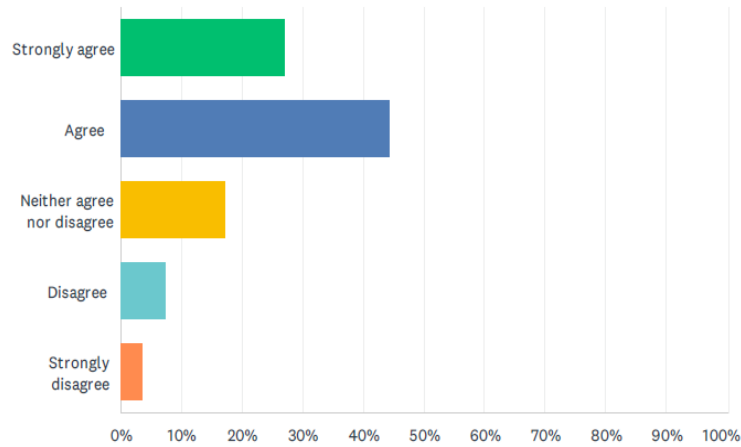

Q13 How much to you agree or disagree with the following statement: "I regularly talk with people in the neighbourhood?"

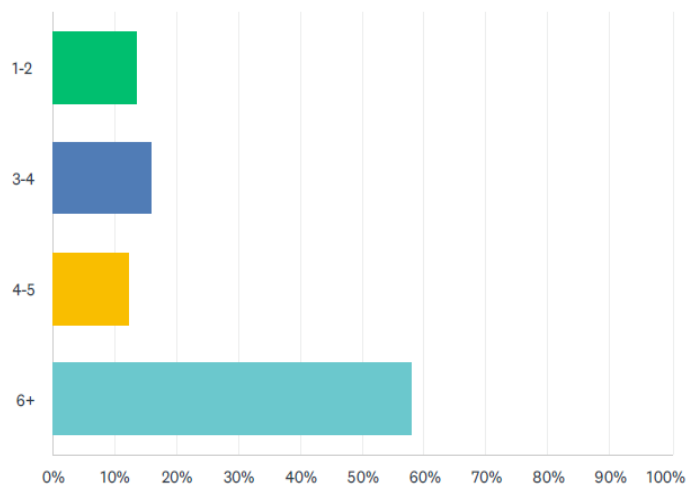

Q14 How many neighbors do you know by name?

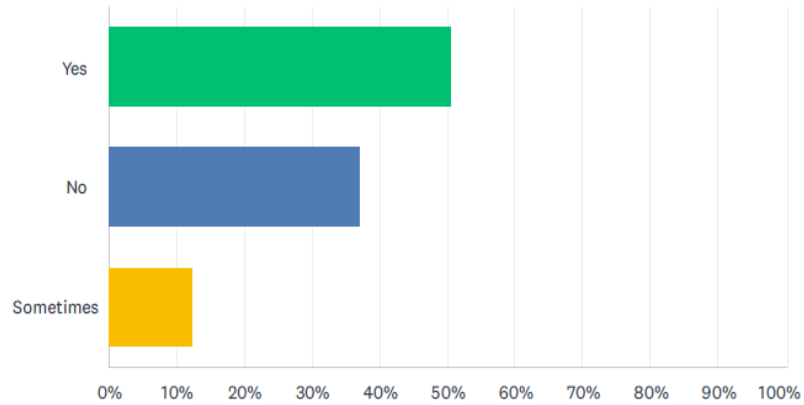

Q15 Does your household compost your green and/or food waste?

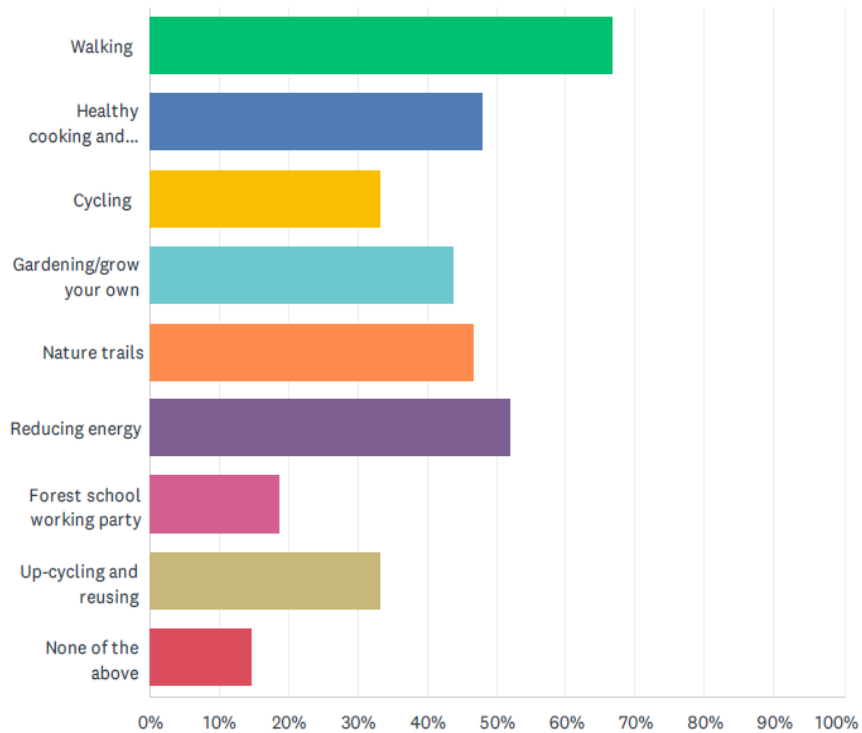

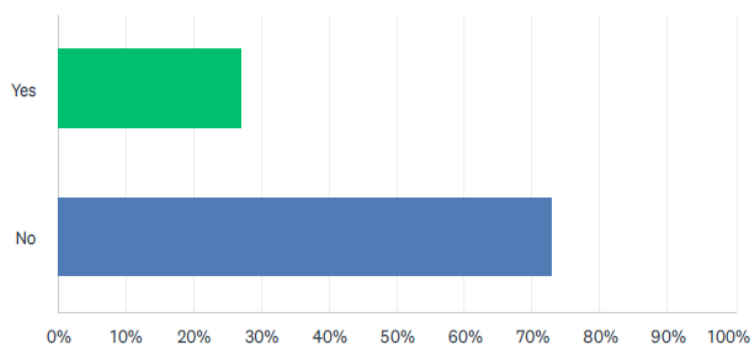

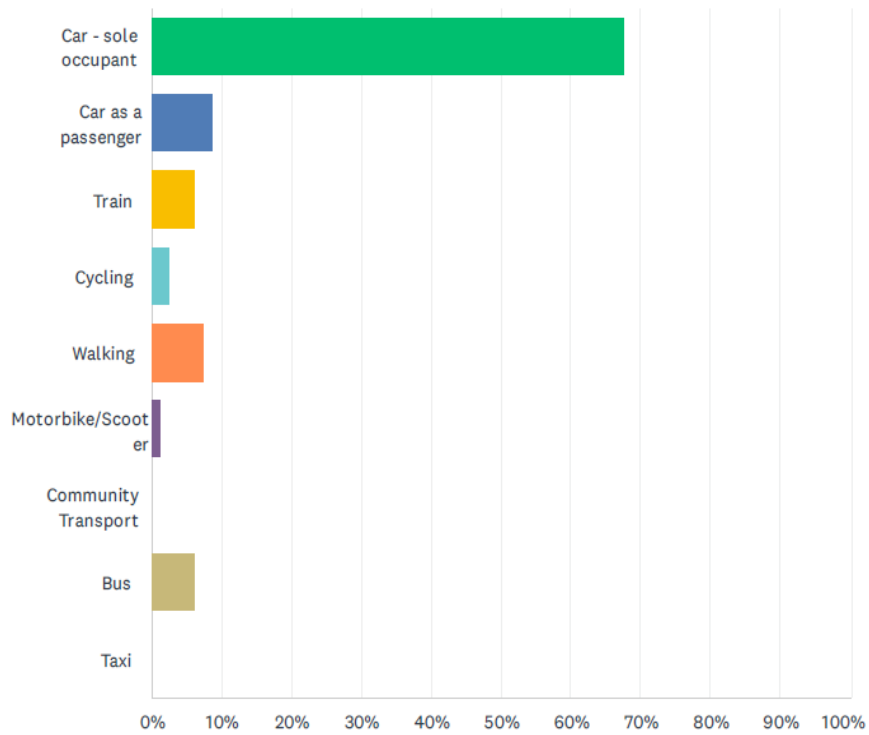
Q19B: If no, describe what challenges you have, if any?

1	But it hasn't been serviced for 4 years as SSE are utterly useless. More than happy to take the money but not really interested in looking after their equipment. When you complain they talk the talk but then do nothing
2	On all of Phase 1, the radiators have been shown to be undersized: our sizes were designed using the wrong (but more common) "delta-T" (difference between radiator midpoint temperature and 20 degrees) - this error has not been made on subsequent phases, which have much larger sizes and capacities (in BTUs) of radiators, for a given room size. However, on all Phases, larger/non-terrace homes struggle to get some rooms warm enough, and/or warm fast enough, in winter. The last plumbing contractor who reviewed our system stated that the original system design won't work without some parts modifications (valves, to allow low flow rate, and power of pumps) - and this is why we struggle so much. The SSE/DPC plumbers have managed to improve the situation by turning up the flow rate, making the radiator midpoint temperatures hotter - but this goes against the original design principles as explained by Mr Giddy. Sadly, even though there is a video online of Mr Giddy stating that the low flow rate and special valves are used everywhere in Elmsbrook, this is not true! So, we are mostly warm enough - but after umpteen visits from A2/SSE/DPC etc etc heating engineers, none of them could fix it, and it is clear that the overall system has not been built as designed - for example, Mr Giddy told us that all homes have 20 degree top-to-bottom temperature differences; when I sent him a scan of the form in our New Home Pack which shows ours were only 6 degrees because they couldn't achieve more, he stopped replying to us!

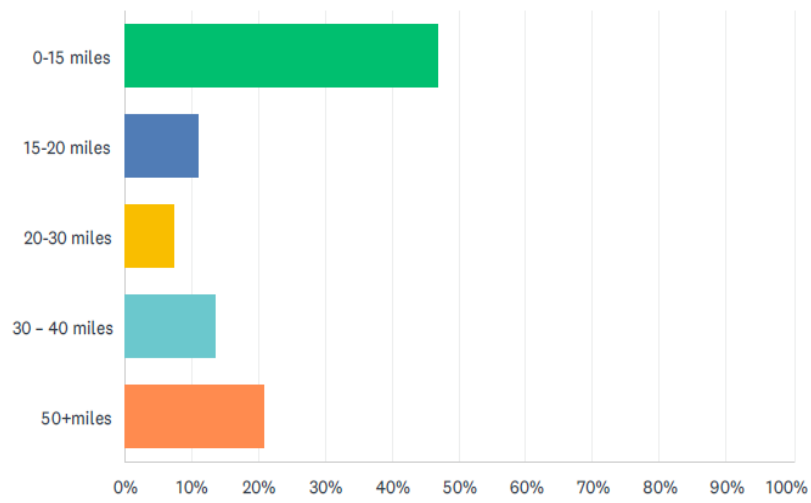

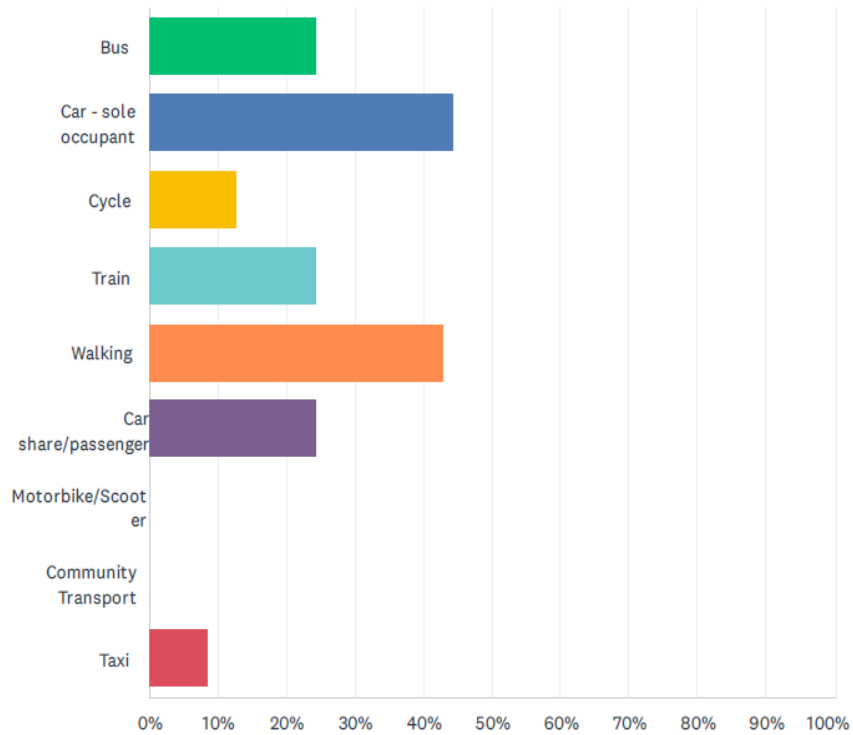

Q22 Do you utilise any other travel modes as part of the most frequent journey travelled in a typical week?

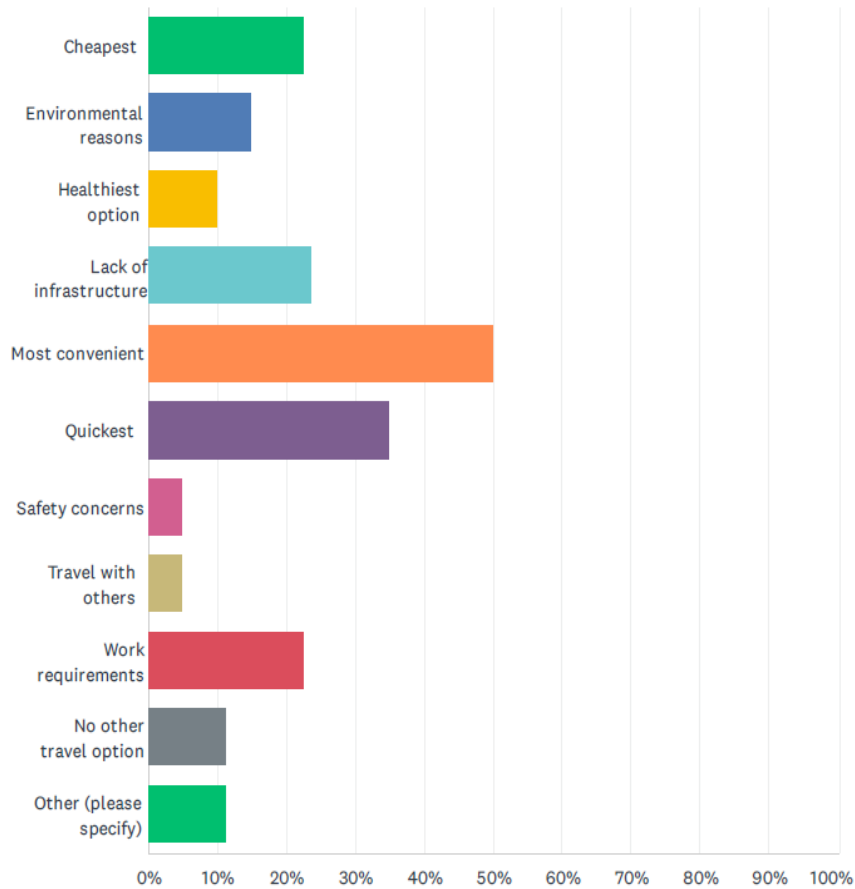

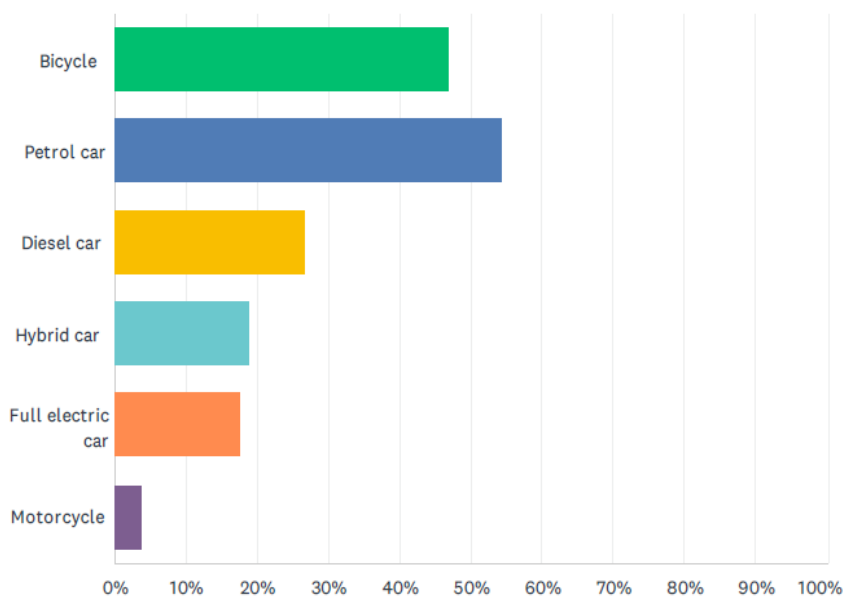

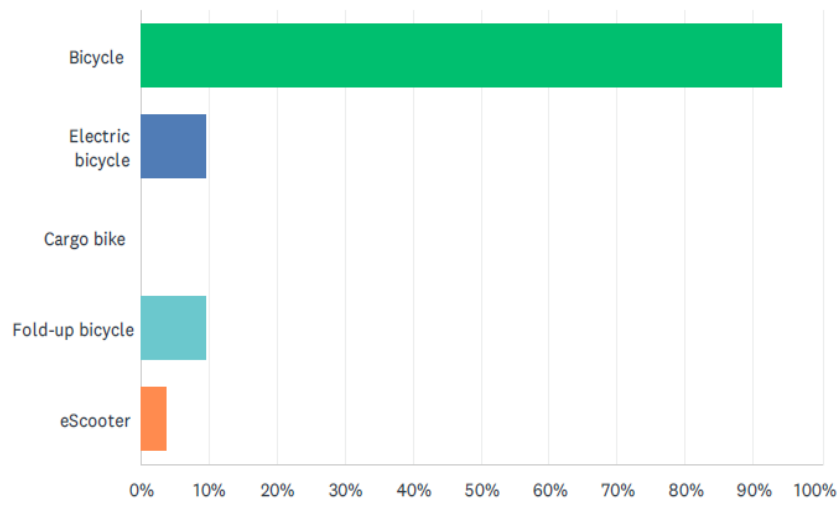

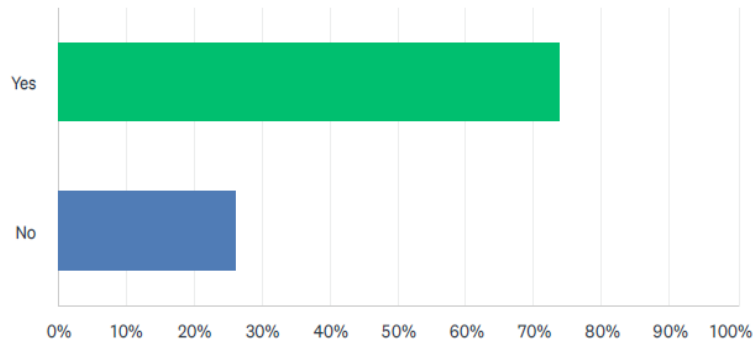
