The LPA has concerns across a number of areas:

- Harm to landscape and visual impact on the countryside;
- Increased dust and noise and the ensuing impact on the residential amenities in the localities, also on the primary school;
- The impact, especially long-term, of tremors and excavations on buildings near the site and along the transport routes, particularly in relation to listed buildings;
- The significant increase in HGV traffic to/from the site through the village and surrounding roads unsuitable for such use;
- The cumulative impact on overall amenity, visual and residential, in the locality;
- Impact on landscape from the intrusion into the buffer zone by the new 'temporary' car park and associated structures; and
- Impact on wildlife and ecology (we note the lack of sufficient information provided).

We have received a number of objections/comments directly, including from Wroxton & Balscote parish council and I will be forwarding these separately.
