Comments	<p>I would like to object to this application in the strongest possible terms for the following reasons:</p> <p>If this application should be granted the public house would have to be closed due to lack of parking, Building more houses in the Sibford gap would look out of place and would cause problems not least because of the narrow lanes surrounding the property and its access. Getting construction traffic in and out of the site would be dangerous and very disruptive to neighbours.</p> <p>The licence for the pub covers the whole site so it would have to be de-licenced surely before any planning could even be considered.
