> I have recently discovered that the allotments which were in the plans as part of the large development on Hook Norton Road in Sibford Ferris have been cancelled from the plans. Had the development prioritised small affordable, sensibly designed houses instead of being the white elephant that has been imposed upon the village then perhaps the decision to axe the allotments could be forgiven, but this really is too much. I urge you to stand up to government plans on development in the future and show some good judgment in stopping the excess of planned building when such development does not lead to genuinely affordable housing and genuine benefit to local communities
