The applicant has submitted an approved addendum to the approved written scheme of investigation. Condition 33 asks for the programme of archaeological investigation to be carried out, and so for the discharge of this condition (full or partial), we would require the submission of a Post-excavation Assessment detailing the fieldwork which has been carried out. We would not recommend partial discharge of condition 33 at this stage, however, can confirm that the archaeological field work in Areas 1 and 3 has been completed and can be handed back to the developer. A PXA is still required for these areas, however.
