Re: Planning Application 25/01346/OUT

I would wish for your department to accept this as an objection to the above referenced outline planning application for housing at the rear of The Moors , Kidlington.

This site was not allocated for development within the adopted local plan and the proposal conflicts with the overall strategy for housing due to its extension in to open countryside.

Land to the north of The Moors is used by many Villagers as public rights of way with excellent views of St Marys Church .

I see no provision in the proposal for any School provision for the Children of the families in the 340 new homes. The nearest Primary School is North Kidlington which is near capacity and existing at present in Porta cabins.
Also with the increased population there is no mention of the impact on the already over stretched NHS Services

The proposal also includes the demolition of 162 The Moors in order to gain a larger access to the site. Why is there a need for another access at Benmead Road ?
The proposed access at the junction of The Moors and Benmead Road will increase the pressure on Highway safety at this narrow Junction.

Why is there a necessity for Cricket pitches in this area and why on an area of land that has poor drainage, The land is regularly flooded.

I trust that Cherwell District Council will oppose this application
