I write to object to the planning proposal of Bloombridge for 340 houses behind the Moors. To my own certain knowledge flooding in these fields as shown on the plan occurs every winter and spring. With houses requiring more tarmac and new roads, and consequently less ability of the land to soak up rainfall etc, flooding will inevitably increase impacting on current housing. Flooding in this area is already a problem and will worsen as climate change produces more extreme events.

The Bloombridge proposal threatens to turn flooding into a crisis.
