Please see below my objection to the proposed planning application to build on the land behind the moors in Kidlington.

Reasoning:

I moved to Kidlington a year ago, and one of the main reasons I chose to buy my home was the beautiful fields and woodland behind The Moors. I walk and run in this green space twice a day, and I believe it plays a vital role in supporting the physical and mental wellbeing of the local community.

Unfortunately, during the winter months, the fields become severely flooded, making them inaccessible. This flooding raises serious concerns about the suitability of the land for housing development and the potential impact such construction could have on the surrounding area—including my property.

Traffic on The Moors is already quite congested during peak hours, largely due to parked cars. A significant increase in housing would only worsen this situation, especially with parents driving children to the nearby primary school.

While I appreciate the need for more housing, I believe the loss of this green space would be a great detriment to local wildlife and to the wider Kidlington community.

Please consider objecting the proposed planning application.
